

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER DISCUSSION PRESENTATIONS

1) A maximum poster dimension of A0 size (80 cm x 120 cm) must not be exceeded and may allow room for a header on top of the poster board.

2) Limit the amount of printed material. Posters should neither be elaborate nor extensive. Supplemental material can be handed out to those viewing your poster.

3) Each poster must have a top label indicating the title of the poster, the names of the authors and their affiliations. The size of the characters for the title should be at least 2cm high.

4) Poster text should be large enough to be read from a distance of 1m or more, a possible using a letter size of at least 1cm.

5) Keep illustrative material simple. Charts, drawings and illustrations should be simple and use of colour may be effective for adding emphasis

6) Prepare simple "Introduction" and "Conclusion" sections. They are usually helpful. When feasible, use graphs for demonstrating qualitative or quantitative relationships. Use only tables if precise numerical values are needed.

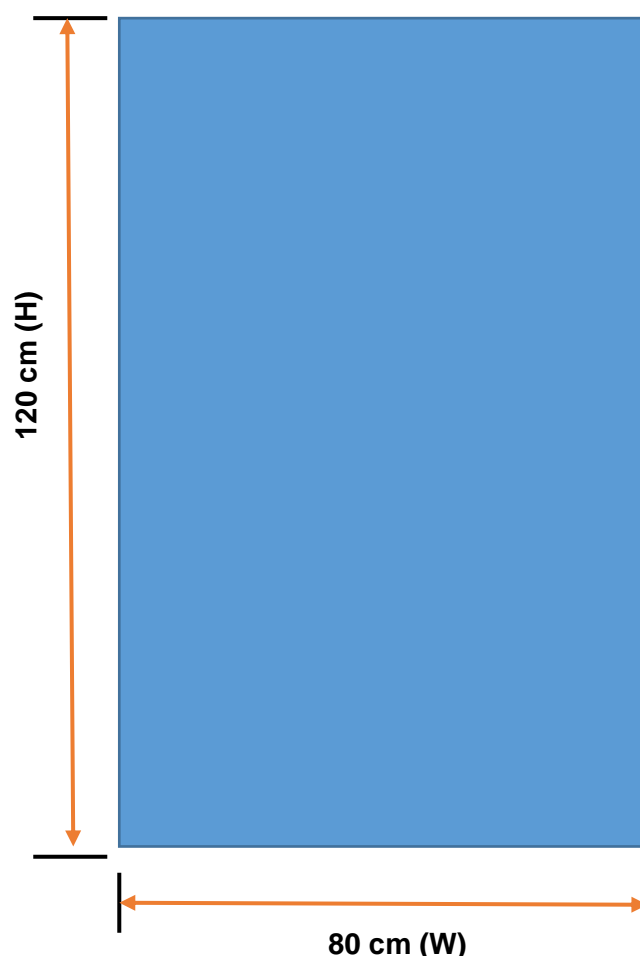
7) Do not mail poster presentation material to ADC secretariat in advance of the meeting. It might not arrive in time; bring the material with you. **The ADC Secretariat does not offer Poster printing service.**
